

CME – FAQ

Q:1: How a RMP (Registered Medical Practitioners) should update the CME CREDIT HOURS in their accounts as per the Recent notification?

RMP can update their CME credit Hours by **Form 5 & Form 7** available in **TNMC** website (or) Click <http://www.tnmedicalcouncil.org/Info/Index?view=cmeprograms>.

- **FORM 5 (Exemption Category)**
 - ✓ **Annexure 1: Annexure (a) Senior Citizen 70 Plus (Born Before - 01.06.1948 only) (As on 31.05.2018).**
 - ✓ **Annexure (b) Teaching Faculties.**
 - ✓ **Annexure (c) Registered Medical Practitioners during their Post Graduate Period. (Diploma / Master / Super Speciality, DNB etc.)**
 - ✓ **Annexure (d) Registered Medical Practitioners in their Sick period. [Credit Hours will be given after proper scrutiny]**
- **FORM 7 (To import credit hour with your CME certificates)**
 - ✓ I want to **Import my Credit Hours** for the certificate issued by **TNMC**.
 - ✓ I want to **Import my Credit Hours** for the certificate issued by **Other state council**.
 - ✓ I want to **Import my Credit Hours** for the certificate of participation in **International CME Programmes**.
 - ✓ I want to **Import my Credit Hours** for the certificate issued by **Association /Institution**.
 - ✓ I want to **Import my Credit Hours** for the certificate of participation in **Online CME-Issued by OMNICURIS**.

Q 2: Who are all exempted from CME credits?

- A. Senior Registered Medical Practitioners Born Before - 01.06.1948 i.e., above 70+ as on 31st May 2018 are exempted and they can apply with necessary documents, fees with application **Form 5. (Annexure (A))**.
- B. Registered Medical Practitioners those who are working as "Teaching Faculties" Private or Govt Medical Colleges or recognised Teaching Institutions can get a certificate of employment in the format available in the **TNMC** website to avail 6 credit hours for per year (Applicable only from **01.06.2012 to till date**), with necessary documents, fees with application **Form 5. (Annexure (B))**.
- C. Similarly Registered Medical Practitioners undergoing/did postgraduate course can submit their course certificate *(instead of CME certificate)* and claim 6 credit hour per year, with necessary documents, fees with application **Form 5. (Annexure (C))**.

D. Any sick Registered Medical Practitioners for more than 2 months can apply with supportive documents and Medical Certificate, format available in TNMC Website (for the period of exemption) . apply with necessary documents, fees with applicant detail **Form 5 (Annexure (D))**.

Q 3: I have attended few CMEs and having certificates, how can I Import my Credit Hours.

- ✓ Register medical practitioner can import their Credit hours, with their CME Certificates by applying with **Form 7** under relevant category with necessary documents, fees with applicant detail, available in **TNMC** website www.tnmedicalcouncil.org or click "<http://www.tnmedicalcouncil.org/Info/Index?view=cmeprograms>".

Q 4: How do i know the Association or Institution are CME Accredited by TNMC ?

- ✓ Can ensure that the Association or institution is accredited in TNMC, by the list available in **TNMC** website www.tnmedicalcouncil.org.

Q 5: If I don't have any CME Credit Hours during the period 2012-17, what should I do?

- ✓ Use the **Form 8** to Pay the fee **Rs. 1500/-** as carry over for the block **2012 – 2017** with required Documents.
- ✓ 30 Credit hours for the period **2012 - 2017** will be carry over to the next block year **01.06.2017 - 31.05.2022** and the Registered Medical practitioner has to complete **60 (30+30) Credit Hours**.

Q 6: I have 10 CME credits hour during the period 2012-17, what should I do?

- ✓ Use **Form 8** to Pay **Rs. 50 /- per** shortage credit hour during 2012 – 2017 block year to carry over **Shortage credit hours** to the next block **01.06.2017 - 31.05.2022** with required Documents.
- ✓ 20 Credit hours for the period 2012 - 2017 will be carry over to the next block year **01.06.2017 – 31.05.2022** and the Registered Medical practitioner has to complete **50 (20+30) Credit Hours**.

Q 7: What does TNMC do to facilitate doctors attend CME and gain credit hours?

- ✓ **TNMC** will make collaboration with institutions/ organisations.
